We need qualified volunteers to serve as facilitators for adult and children's groups as we help bereaved families through free grief support group services.

### **Requirements include:**

- A heart for grieving children, teens and their families
- Willingness to commit to 6-8 evening hours per month for six months to one year or to act as substitute grief group facilitator as needed
- Attending training Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. plus supervision in later GriefWorks sessions. \$75 fee involved for materials, CPR training & meals.
- Ability and desire to learn group facilitation skills
- Insight into own loss history
- Passing a criminal background check
- Personal & professional references
- Fluent in Spanish a plus
